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Foreword

Dear student,


You are now at a crossroads in your life. Your compulsory education is behind you, the upper secondary level lies ahead, and for the first time you must make your own decision about which educational path to pursue. This new freedom also brings responsibilities, and it is up to you to carefully consider the study programmes offered at the upper secondary level. That way you can decide what is right for you, keeping in mind your particular interests and talents.

Everyone has a place in upper secondary education. Iceland has over 30 upper secondary schools, each with its own special emphases and characteristics. All of them have one goal: to provide the best possible education for their students. The programmes offered at the upper secondary level have steadily increased in number and variety over the past few years, and great care is taken to ensure that the learning does not end in a cul-de-sac. This means that students who begin their studies in academic programmes can easily switch over to vocational programmes, and students in vocational programmes can go on to further studies that lead to matriculation. Students also have the option of enrolling in general academic programmes, to better prepare themselves for studies in other programmes or to become more familiar with the options offered before a specific programme is selected.

The purpose of this brochure is to introduce you to the study programmes offered at the upper secondary level, as well as the programmes and services offered by individual upper secondary schools. Further information about the schools, their special positions and characteristics may be found on their individual websites. This brochure also contains information about compulsory school grades required for admission into individual study programmes. It is important for students to be familiar with such requirements before submitting an application. Upper secondary school registration is electronic, meaning that applications for admission are submitted online.

We live in times of frequent change. Exciting study and work opportunities often lie in fields that students have not had much experience with while growing up. For example, much progress has been made in technical and vocational training in various fields. I would therefore encourage you to look carefully into the vocational and technical training offered at the upper secondary level. I would also urge students whose mother tongue is not Icelandic to look into which schools offer courses or programmes in Icelandic as a Second Language.

I hope this brochure proves useful to you in the daunting but exciting task of selecting an upper secondary school. I wish you all the best for the future, and an enjoyable and rewarding time in a school that is right for you.

Inngangur

Þessum bæklingi er ætlað að kynna fyrir erlendum grunnskólanemendum, foreldrum þeirra eða forráðamönnum, það nám sem er í boði í íslenskum framhaldsskólum. Í bæklingum er að finna almennar upplýsingar um framhaldskólann, innritun, inntökuskilyrði, ýmsar undanþágur og inntökuskilyrði. Einnig er að finna skilyrði sem nemendur á framhaldsskólastigi þurfa að uppfylla til að eiga rétt á námsstyrkjum til jöfnunar á námskostnaði.

Vakin er athygli á að á heimasíðum framhaldsskólanna má finna ítarlegri upplýsingar og eru nemendur og foreldrar/forráðamenn þeirra hvattir til að kynna sér efni þeirra.

Birtar eru töflur sem sýna hvaða námsbrautir hver skóli býður fram og þar er hægt að sjá hvaða skólar bjóða uppá sérstakar námsbrautir í íslensku fyrir útlendinga. Einnig er að finna skrá yfir skólana, símanúmer, netföng og vefböng.

Síðasti dagur til að sækja um skólavist í framhaldsskóla árið 2008 er 11. júní.

Introduction

The purpose of this brochure is to introduce the study opportunities available in Icelandic upper secondary schools to non-Icelandic compulsory school pupils and their parents or guardians.

This brochure provides comprehensive information about upper secondary schools, registration for upper secondary education, admission requirements, various types of exemptions, and criteria that upper secondary school students must fulfil to qualify for grants to balance out their study costs.

Please note that more extensive information, which pupils and their parents/guardians are encouraged to look into, may be found on the websites of the individual upper secondary schools.

This brochure contains tables that show the various programmes offered by different schools, including which schools offer programmes in Icelandic for Foreign Students. Information about the schools, such as their telephone numbers, e-mail addresses and websites, is also included.

The deadline for applications to upper secondary schools is 11 June in 2008.

Almennt um nám í framhaldsskóla

Nemendur sem eru að hefja framhaldsskólanám eru ólíkir hvað varðar undirbúning, þroska, áhugamál og námsgetu. Námsskipulag og nám á framhaldsskólastigi miðast m.a. við að koma til móts við þessar ólíku þarfir með því að bjóða fram fjölbreyttar námsleiðir og veita þannig tækifæri til að stunda nám eftir áhugasviði hvers og eins.

Miklu máli skiptir að nemendur kynni sér vel námsframboð framhaldsskóla, geri sér sem besta grein fyrir hvaða nám þeir vilja helst stunda og sækji um nám sem er í samræmi við undirbúning þeirra. Einnig er mikilvægt að foreldrar/forráðamenn kynni sér vel námsframboð skóla og ræði almennt við börn sín um val á framhaldsnámi og möguleika í þeim efnum. Sjálfsagt er að leita til umsjónarkennara í grunnskóla og námsráðgjafa um aðstoð við val á námi í framhaldsskóla. Einnig geta nemendur grunnskóla leitað beint til framhaldsskóla um upplýsingar og ráðgjöf.

Nám í framhaldsskólum greinist á fjölmargar námsbrautir sem eru ólíkar að inntaki og lengd. Þessir skólar eru ýmist nefndir fjölbrautaskólar, framhaldsskólar, iðnskólar, menntaskólar eða verkmenntaskólar

Sumir framhaldsskólar bjóða aðeins upp á nám á bóknamsbrautum en aðrir eru bæði með starfsnám og bóklegt nám. Í nokkrum framhaldsskólum er í boði nám sem skipulagt er sérstaklega fyrir útlendinga (sjá töflu). Það getur verið fölgandi í kennslu í sérstökum íslenskuáföngum, kennslu í tilteknum námsgreinum á erlendum málum eða sérstökum námsbrautum svo sem IB-nám í Menntaskólanum í Hamrahlíð. Sumir þeirra skóla sem ekki er merkt við bjóða nemendum með annað móðurmál en íslensku sérstaka aðstoð í námi. Nemendur eru hvattir til að hafa samband við skóla sem þeir hafa áhuga á að sækja um og kanna hvaða þjónusta er í boði. Allir skólar starfa samkvæmt aðalnámskrá framhaldsskóla.

General Information

Students embarking on upper secondary education vary in terms of readiness, maturity, interests and aptitude for learning. Study programmes and the arrangement of studies at the upper secondary level are designed to meet those diverse requirements by offering a variety of programmes, thereby providing students with the opportunity for education that is in line with their areas of interest.

It is essential for students to familiarise themselves with the types of programmes offered at the upper secondary level, to become aware of which studies best appeal to them, and to apply for programmes that match with the foundation they already have. It is also important for parents/guardians to study the types of programmes offered by individual schools and to discuss with their children the process of selecting programmes and the options available to them. The child's compulsory school teacher or educational counsellor can also provide assistance with the selection process. Pupils at the compulsory level can moreover contact upper secondary schools directly for information and advice.

Upper secondary school education is divided into diverse programmes of study that vary in composition and length. Some upper secondary schools offer only academic study programmes, others offer both vocational and academic programmes. Some upper secondary schools offer programmes specifically designed for foreign students (see table). This may include certain courses being offered in Icelandic or certain subjects being taught in foreign languages, and may extend to entire programmes such as the International Baccalaureate programme at Menntaskólinn í Hamrahlíð. Some schools offer students whose mother tongue is not Icelandic special help with learning, even when this is not specifically denoted. Students are urged to contact the school to which they wish to apply to find out what types of services are provided.

All schools operate in accordance with the National Curriculum Guide.

Innritun í framhaldsskóla 2008

Innritun í framhaldsskóla er rafræn, þ.e. sótt er um skólavist á netinu. Nemendur í 10. bekk fá veflykil sem opnar þeim persónulegan aðgang að innrituninni. Nemendur sækja um veflykil á menntagatt.is/innritun og fá hann sendan í tölvupósti. Foreldrar/forráðamenn fá einnig bréf frá menntamálaráðuneytinu þar sem gerð er grein fyrir fyrirkomulagi innritunarinnar.

Hvenær hefst innritunin?

Opnað verður fyrir innritunin 14. maí. Frá þeim tíma geta umsækjendur fyllt úr rafræna umsókn á netinu. Hægt er vinna umsóknina í áföngum og breytingar má gera þar til umsóknarfresti lýkur. Nemendur 10. bekkjar eru hvattir til að fylla út umsókn snemma því þannig komast óskir þeirra sem fyrst til skila. Umsóknum má samt sem áður breyta þar til umsóknarfrestur rennur út.

Hvaða aðstöðu þarf?

Þar sem innritunin fer fram á netinu þurfa nemendur að komast í nettengda tölvu til að geta sótt um. Hægt er að komast í nettengdar tölvur bæði í grunnskólum og framhaldskólum.

Þarf að senda eitthvað með umsóknunum?

Nemendur 10. bekkjar þurfa ekki að senda afrit af prófskírteinum úr 10. bekk með umsóknum. Einkunnirnar verða sendar rafrænt til þess skóla sem sótt er um. Vottorð eða sérstakar upplýsingar um nemendur, sem ekki er að finna á rafræna umsóknareyðublaðinu, verður hins vegar að senda í pósti til skólans.

Hvar má fá aðstoð og ráðgjöf?

Námsráðgjafar í grunn- og framhaldsskólum þekkja vel til náms á framhaldsskólastigi og eru umsækjendur hvattir til að leita upplýsinga og ráðgjafar hjá þeim.

Hvernig er sótt um?

Á menntagatt.is er að finna rafrænt umsóknareyðublað með leiðbeiningum. Þar eru einnig ýmsar upplýsingar um nám í framhaldsskólum.

Umsóknarfrestur rennur út á miðnætti 11. júní 2008.

Registration for upper secondary school studies in 2008

Registration for upper secondary school studies is electronic, i.e. applications are submitted online. Pupils in grade 10 are given a webkey that provides personal access to the registration area. Pupils may apply for a webkey on menntagatt.is/innrifun and will subsequently receive it sent by e-mail. Parents/guardians will also receive a letter from the Ministry of Education, Science and Culture providing them with information concerning the registration process.

When does registration begin?

Registration begins on 14 May. From that date onwards, students can fill out an online application. The application may be filled out in stages and amendments made until the application deadline has passed. Pupils in grade 10 are urged to fill in their application early to get their requests in as soon as possible. Applications may still be amended until the application deadline has passed.

What is required?

As registration is online, students need to have access to a computer with an Internet connection in order to submit their applications. Such access is provided both in compulsory schools and upper secondary schools.

What documents must accompany the application?

Pupils in grade 10 need not submit copies of their grade 10 results with their applications, as their grades will be sent electronically to the schools to which they apply. Certificates or special information about pupils that cannot be included with the electronic application must be sent to the relevant school by regular post.

Who provides assistance or advice?

Educational counsellors in compulsory and upper secondary schools are familiar with upper secondary education, and applicants are urged to seek information and advice from them.

How is the application submitted?

An electronic application form and instructions on how to fill it out are available on menntagatt.is. Diverse information about upper secondary education may also be found there.

The deadline for applications is midnight on 11 June 2008

Aðalnámskrá framhaldsskóla og skólanámskrár

Almennir framhaldsskólar starfa eftir aðalnámskrá framhaldsskóla. Í henni er að finna upplýsingar um markmið og skipulag námsbrauta og námsgreina. Þar eru einnig ýmsar reglur er varða réttindi og skyldur nemenda og skóla. Aðalnámskrá framhaldsskóla er birt í heild sinni á heimasíðu menntamálaráðuneytisins, www.menntamalaraduneyt.is. Allir framhaldsskólar gefa út sínar eigin skólanámskrár. Í þeim eru birtar nánari upplýsingar um starfssemi hvers skóla, námsframboð, skólareglur og þjónustu þá sem nemendum stendur til boða. Skólanámskrár má finna á heimasíðum skólanna.

Ýmis ákvæði og undanþágur

Í aðalnámskrá framhaldsskólanna – almennur hluti 2004 – er að finna reglur og ákvæði um réttindi og skyldur nemenda. Hér á eftir eru birt ýmis ákvæði og undanþágur sem er að finna í aðalnámskrá.

- Fatlaðir nemendur og nemendur með lesröskun (lestrar- og skriftarörðugleika) og/eða aðra staðfesta skynjunarörðugleika geta sótt um undanþágu til skólameistara frá einstökum námsáföngum enda sé fullreynt að mati skóla að nemandinn geti ekki náð tókum á námsefninu vegna skilgreindra annmarka sem sérfræðingur á viðkomandi sviði hefur staðfest. Nemendur skulu þó taka aðra áfanga í stað þeirra sem þeir fá undanþágu frá.
- Nemendur geta einnig sótt um undanþágu til skólameistara frá einni námsgrein ef þeir eiga við það mikla námsörðugleika að stríða að þeir geta ekki náð tókum á námsefninu þrátt fyrir endurteknar tilraunir og þrátt fyrir sérstaka aðstoð frá viðkomandi skóla. Slíkir námsörðugleikar skulu staðfestir af sérfræðingi á viðkomandi sviði. Nemendur sem fá undanþágu samkvæmt þessu skulu þó taka aðra grein í staðinn.
- Nemendur, sem hafa annað móðurmál en íslensku, og íslenskir nemendur, sem hafa dvalið lengi erlendis og hafa þar af leiðandi takmarkaða kunnáttu í málinu, geta sótt um að stunda nám í íslensku samkvæmt sérstakri námskrá sem ætluð er þessum nemendum. Sama gildir um heyrnarlausu nemendur.

The National Curriculum Guide for Upper Secondary Schools, and School Curriculum Guides

Regular upper secondary schools in Iceland operate in line with the National Curriculum Guide for Upper Secondary Schools, which lays down the objectives and organisation of study programmes and subjects. It also provides information about rules regarding the rights and responsibilities of students and institutions. The National Curriculum Guide for Upper Secondary Schools may be viewed in its entirety on the Ministry of Education, Science and Culture's website, www.menntamalaraduneyti.is. All upper secondary schools also work according to their own school curriculum guides. Those incorporate more specific information about the operations of each school, courses offered, school regulations and the types of services provided for students. School curriculum guides may be viewed on the websites of the individual schools.

Provisions and exemptions

The National Curriculum Guide for Upper Secondary Schools – General Section 2004 – incorporates regulations and provisions concerning the rights and responsibilities of students. The following provisions and exemptions are found in the National Curriculum Guide:

- Disabled student and students with reading disabilities (reading and writing disabilities) and/or other confirmed sensory disabilities, may apply to the school principal to be exempted from individual courses. This is presuming the school's assessment that the student in question is unable to grasp the course materials as a result of specific disabilities that have been confirmed by a specialist in the relevant field. Students who are granted such an exemption should take other courses in lieu.
- Students may also apply to the principal for exemptions from a particular subject if their learning disabilities render them unable to grasp the course materials despite repeated attempts and assistance provided by the school. Such learning disabilities must be confirmed by a specialist in the relevant field. Students who are granted such exemptions should take other subjects in lieu.
- Students whose mother tongue is not Icelandic, and Icelandic students who have spent long periods overseas and who therefore have limited competence in Icelandic, can apply to study Icelandic according to a special curriculum designed for those students. The same applies to deaf students.

- Hafi viðkomandi nemandi dvalið utan Norðurlanda þá getur hann sótt um að taka annað tungumál í staðinn fyrir Norðurlandamál.
- Nemendur sem fengið hafa undanþágu frá námi í Norðurlandamáli í grunnskóla geta einnig fengið undanþágu frá Norðurlandamáli í framhaldsskóla. Þeir skulu þó taka aðra grein í staðinn.
- Áður en undanþága er veitt skal skólameistari gera nemendum grein fyrir því að undanþágan gæti skert möguleika þeirra til náms í skólum á háskólastigi eða möguleika til starfa á viðkomandi starfssviði ef um starfsnám er að ræða.
- Framhaldsskóli skal koma til móts við afreksíþróttafólk á þann hátt að fjarvera þess á námsstíma, vegna keppnis- og/eða æfingaferða landsliðs í viðkomandi íþróttgrein, reiknast ekki inn í skólasóknareinkunn nemandans.
- Nemandi, sem stundar umfangsmikla líkamsþjálfun á vegum sérsambands og/eða íþróttafélags, undir stjórn sérmenntaðs þjálfara, íþróttfræðings eða kennara, samhliða námi í framhaldsskóla, getur óskað eftir því að skólameistari veiti honum undanþágu frá vissum áföngum eða áfangahlutum í íþróttum, líkams- og heilsurækt.

Námsstyrkir

Nemendur sem stunda reglubundið nám á framhaldsskólastigi hér á landi eiga rétt á námsstyrkjum til jöfnunar á námskostnaði að uppfylltum ákveðnum skilyrðum. Almenn skilyrði fyrir styrk er búseta og/eða skólasókn fjarri lögheimili námsmanns og lögheimili nánustu fjölskyldu, þ.e. foreldra/forráðamanns og gildir þetta um alla nemendur hvar sem þeir eru búsettir.

Námsstyrkjanefnd úthlutar styrkjum til styrkhæfra nemenda. Auglýst er eftir umsóknum um námsstyrki á og skulu umsóknir berast á þar til gerðum eyðublöðum.

Námsstyrkjanefnd hefur vinnuáðstöðu í húsakynnum Lánasjóðs íslenskra námsmanna. Sjóðurinn annast alla umsýslu og nauðsynlega framkvæmd fyrir nefndina og veitir upplýsingar um styrkina. LÍN tekur m.a. við umsóknum um námsstyrki og sér um úrvinnslu þeirra.

- Students who have resided outside the Nordic countries can apply to study a language in lieu of one of the Nordic languages.
- Students who have been granted an exemption from studying a Nordic language in compulsory school can also be granted such an exemption in upper secondary school. In such cases, they are required take another subject in lieu.
- Before an exemption is granted, the principal should inform the student in question that the exemption might affect his or her study opportunities at the higher education level, or the opportunity for work in a specific field if the study programme is a vocational one.
- Exceptional athletes should be accommodated in such a way as to allow their school absences as a result of games and/or training for the national team to be overlooked when calculating a grade for school attendance.
- Students who parallel to their studies in an upper secondary school are engaged in extensive physical training under the auspices of a special sports association and/or athletics association with a trained coach, athletics instructor or teacher, can apply to the principal to be exempt from specific courses or parts of courses in athletics or physical education.

Study grants

Students engaged in regular study at the upper secondary level in Iceland are entitled to grants to balance out the cost of their studies, pending certain conditions. A general condition for receiving such a grant is that the student reside and/or attend school far away from his or her legal domicile and also the legal domicile of his or her immediate family, i.e. parents/guardians. This applies to all students, regardless of where they live.

The Study Grants Committee allocates grants to those students who are eligible. Applications for study grants are solicited by means of advertising and applications should be submitted on forms provided for that purpose.

The Study Grants Committee has its operations on the same premises as the Icelandic Student Loans Fund (ISLF). The fund oversees all administration and necessary activities for the committee and provides information about the grants. The ISLF accepts the grant applications, among other things, and is responsible for processing them.

Námsbrautir í framhaldsskólum

Námsbrautum í framhaldsskóla er skipt í nokkra meginflokka:

- Almenn námsbraut – opin öllum nemendum sem ekki hafa gert upp hug sinn varðandi áframhaldandi nám í framhaldsskóla og nemendum sem lokið hafa grunnskólaprófi en uppfylla ekki skilyrði til inngöngu á lengri námsbrautum.
- Bóknámsbrautir og annað nám til stúdentsprófs. Bóknámsbrautirnar eru: Félagsfræðabraut, málabraut, náttúrufræðibraut og viðskipta- og hagræðibraut. Einnig er mögulegt að ljúka stúdentsprófi með viðbótarnámi af öðrum brautum t.d. starfsnámsbrautum.
- Listnámsbraut. Námið tekur þrjú ár og undirbýr nemendur undir áframhaldandi nám og störf á sviði lista.
- Starfsbrautir eru ætlaðar nemendum sem hafa notið verulegrar sérkennslu í grunnskóla og ekki hafa forsendur til þess að stunda nám á öðrum námsbrautum.
- Starfsnámsbrautir. Þetta er lang stærsti flokkur námsbrauta í framhaldsskólum. Nám á starfsnámsbraut veitir undirbúning til tiltekinna starfa eða áframhaldandi náms. Margar starfsnámsbrautir leiða til ákveðinna starfsréttinda.

Inntökuskilyrði

Mismunandi skilyrði um námsárangur í grunnskóla eru fyrir innritun á ólíkar námsbrautir. Þau skilyrði geta ekki átt við að öllu leyti fyrir nemendur sem stundað hafa nám erlendis eða eiga sér annað móðurmál en íslensku. Skólarnir koma til móts við þá nemendur með því að laga inntökuskilyrði að aðstæðum þeirra og leiðbeina um hvernig þeir geti uppfyllt kröfur sem gerðar eru um nám á ólíkum námsbrautum.

Study Programmes in Upper Secondary Schools

Study programmes in upper secondary schools are divided into several main categories:

- General academic programmes – open to all students who have not decided on further study in upper secondary schools, and those who hold a compulsory school diploma but do not fulfil criteria for admission into longer academic programmes.
- Academic study programmes leading to matriculation. The academic study programmes are: Study programme in social sciences, study programme in languages, study programme in natural history and study programme in business and economics. A matriculation examination may also be taken through additional study from other programmes, such as vocational study programmes.
- Study programme in the arts. The programme is three years in duration and prepares students for continued study and work in the arts.
- Study programmes for disabled students are intended for students who have received a substantial quantity of special education in compulsory school and who do not have the foundation to study in other programmes.
- Vocational study programmes. This is by far the largest category of study programmes in upper secondary schools. Study in a vocational programme provides preparation for specific vocations or continued study. Many of the vocational study programmes lead to specific professional qualifications.

Admission Requirements

Different study programmes require different grades from compulsory schools as prerequisites for admission. Such requirements cannot fully apply to students who have studied abroad or whose mother tongue is not Icelandic. Schools show flexibility for those students by adapting admission requirements to their circumstances and offering guidance on how they can fulfil requirements for admission into different study programmes.

Töflur yfir námsframboð á framhaldsskólastigi

Hér fara á eftir upplýsingar um fyrirhugað námsframboð á framhaldsskólastigi á skólaárinu 2008-2009. Í töfluformi má sjá hvaða námsbrautir eru í boði í hverjum skóla.

Skólarnir eru flokkaðir eftir landshlutum: Reykjavík, Reykjanes, Vesturland, Vestfirðir, Norðurland, Austurland og Suðurland. Tekið er fram að upplýsingar um námsframboð eru gefnar með þeim fyrirvara að nám er fellt niður sé nemendafjöldi ekki nægur til þess að halda því uppi.

Nemendur eru hvattir til að snúa sér til viðkomandi skóla um frekari upplýsingar.

Study programmes offered at the upper secondary level

The following tables provide information about the expected availability of study programmes at the upper secondary level during the 2008-2009 school year. The tables show which study programmes are offered at each school.

The schools are divided into regions: Reykjavík, Reykjanes, West Iceland, the West Fjords, North Iceland, East Iceland and South Iceland. It should be noted that information about availability of study programmes is provided with the provision that they will be cancelled should there not be a sufficient number of enrolments to run them.

Students are encouraged to contact the relevant schools for more information.
